BUILD YOUR BOAT & BRING IT WITH YOU OR BUILD YOUR BOAT WITH US

BASIC RULES

Be safe ~ have fun! Minimum age of 7 to set sail alone
No sharp objects on-board vessels
Any boat deemed unsafe to others (or to the river) will be disqualified
This is a substance-free family event. No alcohol. Smoking is discouraged
All "sailors" must wear Coast-Guard approved PFDs ~ bring your own
Release forms must be signed by participant, parent, or legal guardian over age 18
Boats may be pre-built or built on-site ~ all boats will compete within their own class
The "cabin" of the boat (where the crew sits) may not be enclosed above shoulder height



Boats, boat parts, & debris, must be completely removed from the river & the park. Crews must take Recyclable Boats with them. Cardboard Boats may be left on-site for removal by Hudson Crossing volunteers (please place in appropriate designated area). Hudson Crossing events are environmentally friendly. Please help us leave the river cleaner than we find it! If in doubt, refer to rule #1. Be safe ~ have fun!

SUPPLIES & MATERIALS

Everyone on the water must wear a COAST GUARD APPROVED PFD (Personal Floatation Device) ~ YOU MUST BRING YOUR OWN ~

No staples * No sharp objects * No laminated, waxed, oiled or peeled surfaces * No Sono-tubes

Nothing that will pollute the river

Plastic or wooden brooms are ok * Flat canoe paddles are ok * No double or "scoop" paddles allowed

Cardboard (corrugated only) any amount is ok and bigger sheets work well
We suggest a flat-bottomed design, try building a manila folder model first.

A long slender boat is faster and a short rounded boat is easier to navigate - compromise.

Duct tape or paper tape, in any amount, is ok - Use lots! (Hint: duct tape may shrink when painted)

Latex-based paints are ok (oil-based paints are not) If you paint your boat it must be dry before launching

Caulk is ok * Glue is ok * No foam, plastic or rubber in the Cardboard Boats

For 100% Recyclable Boats Only:

Almost anything goes - as long as it isn't dangerous or polluting - and it can't have been a real boat in any previous form! You might use soda bottles, milk jugs, plastic sleds, barrels, plastic swimming pools....use your imagination And ~ of course, you must recycle it after the race.

Enjoy a day filled with fun, laughter, good food, good music, good friends, and unbelievably great photo opportunities! Whether you come as a crew member, the captain, or an on-shore cheerleader, we promise you a day you'll never forget. Mark your calendar today.

Hudson Crossing is a bi-county educational park, free and open to the public every day from dawn until dusk. It is centered around the Champlain Canal Lock 5 Island on Route 4 just north of the Village of Schuylerville. Come enjoy waterfront trails, a picnic pavilion, the canal overlook, a floating dock, and the Hudson Crossing Play Garden which will be completed this summer. Watch boats "locking through" the canal or take a ride on the Caldwelle Belle Riverboat.
