The month of March brings us longer and warmer days, the start of spring and the eternal hope of new life and better days. The next meeting of the Town Board is scheduled for Monday, March 8th at 7:00 p.m. Some of the items that will be covered at this meeting include: zoning officer's report, town clerk's report, supervisor's report, committee reports, Campground amendment to Zoning Law, Highway Department Inter-municipal Agreements, and town park updates. On Thursday, March 4^h the Town Board will conduct their monthly agenda meeting at which they will review agenda items scheduled for the March 8th meeting plus a presentation by Marvin and Company on a new community Block Grant Proposal, a presentation on the Towpath trail in Schuylerville, discussion of a water district in the town, a Building Use Policy, and the Summer Swimming Program.

Schuylerville Dissolution Study Update

The Village of Schuylerville Dissolution Committee has been meeting monthly to gather information and study all aspects related to the possible dissolution of the Village of Schuylerville. At last month's Town Board Agenda meeting Tim Weidemann of Fairweather Consulting and Schuylerville Mayor John Sherman reviewed the process that would be followed in the study. A meeting open to all Village and Town Residents will be held on Wednesday, March 3rd at the Legion at 7:00 pm. At this meeting residents will learn about the process and will have their questions answered and given an opportunity for input. Mike Fay and Bob Stokes serve as representative of the Town of Saratoga on the committee. A vote by the residents of the Village of Schuylerville on the Dissolution will be conducted in **March 2011**.

The **Town Park Committee** continues to work diligently. They had a successful fall, thanks in large part to the mild late season weather. The following summarizes the progress that has been made:

- Additional organic material spread and incorporated by the local farming community
- Tommell Associates completed survey and set grade stakes
- Morris Excavation completed final grade of the field
- Seeded the north slope.
- Installed the electric service.
- Installed the water pump.
- Irrigation system bid was awarded to Rainbow Lawn Sprinklers. The system was installed and is fully operational.
- Had a volunteer work day to hang fabric on the perimeter fencing
- Anvil Fencing installed the baseball and softball backstops and fencing.
- Dennis Flynn and the BOCES program cleared the hiking trails.
- Installed 316,000 sq ft of sod on the playing fields and immediate surrounds. Many thanks to the numerous volunteers who made this possible, namely Drumm & Ayres Turf Services, Brookside Nursery and Grasshopper Gardens, all of whom donated time, labor and equipment to complete the project. Thanks also goes to the many community members as well as staff, coaches and students at Schuylerville Central School, including FFA classes and the Honor Society, for their time and help.
